Your System

To run Speci•Fire, you should have the following:

- Microsoft Windows 2000 SP3 or higher
- Administrative privileges on the system if running Windows NT, Windows 2000, or Windows XP
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 or higher if running Windows 98 or Windows NT.
- Super VGA monitor with a screen resolution set to at least 1024 x 768, small fonts
- 32 MB of RAM

Previous Versions of Speci•Fire

This setup does not affect existing installations (such as Speci•Fire Plus 1.1); but it does add another folder and shortcut to Speci•Fire 1.5.

Setup Notes

Running Speci•Fire requires that you have certain Microsoft system components installed on your system. If you have an older operating system (pre- Windows 2000 SP3), you may need to install the following components:

- MDAC 2.6 or higher ([download from Microsoft site](#))

If Windows prompts you to reboot your system, you will need to do so or Speci•Fire will not run properly.

Additional Software – Adobe Acrobat Reader
